Official Rules & Regulations of R.A.F.T.

1. RAFT is presented by the Huntingdon County Arts Council (HCAC) on June 12, 2010 from 10 am to 4 pm at Portstown Park, Penn & 8thStreets in Huntingdon, PA 16652.
2. Art vendors' work must be of their original design.
3. Set up starts at 7am and is to be completed by 9:30.
4. Vendors agree to occupy the assigned booth space and to be open and staffed during festival hours.
5. The HCAC will only supply the booth space. There are no refunds or rain checks in case of inclement weather. The HCAC is under no obligation to provide other services of any nature.
6. The Vendor is responsible for delivery, handling, erection and removal of their displays and equipment. All displays, equipment and supplies must be contained in the assigned booth space. Tents & displays MUST be firmly anchored and secured.
7. The HCAC will not be liable for refunds or liabilities due to acts of God, public enemy, strikes, statutes, ordinances or other legal authority, or another cause beyond the HCAC's control.
8. All pertinent Fire Codes, laws, ordinances and regulations pertaining to health, fire prevention, and public safety shall be strictly obeyed. Nothing shall be nailed, taped, or otherwise fixed to any community or private property.
9. The Vendor will be required to have any and all business licenses, permits, and requisite insurance for the operation of his/her business. The Vendor is responsible for paying all sales and other taxes pertaining to his/her business.
10. Applicants have to submit signed application with payment to be eligible for set up.
11. The Vendor agrees to save and hold harmless the Borough of Huntingdon, the HCAC, and all of its representatives from all cost and damage to any person or property whatsoever, which is caused by any activity, condition, or event arising out of the performance or non-performance of any provision of this agreement.

This contract constitutes the entire contract between parties and no waivers, modifications, or amendments shall be valid unless written upon and attached hereto and shall be approved in writing by the HCAC.
